Single room for the first
few days
Be sure it's a quiet place
Litter box, food, water
Spend lots of one-on-one
time, even if they are
hiding

Make Introductions

Slowly introduce to other
pets
Mutual play and feeding
times
Grooming times

The Timid Cat

Sit by their hiding spot
Talk to them out loud in a
soothing voice
Offer high value treats or
wand toys to entice them
